Some of us came to school.

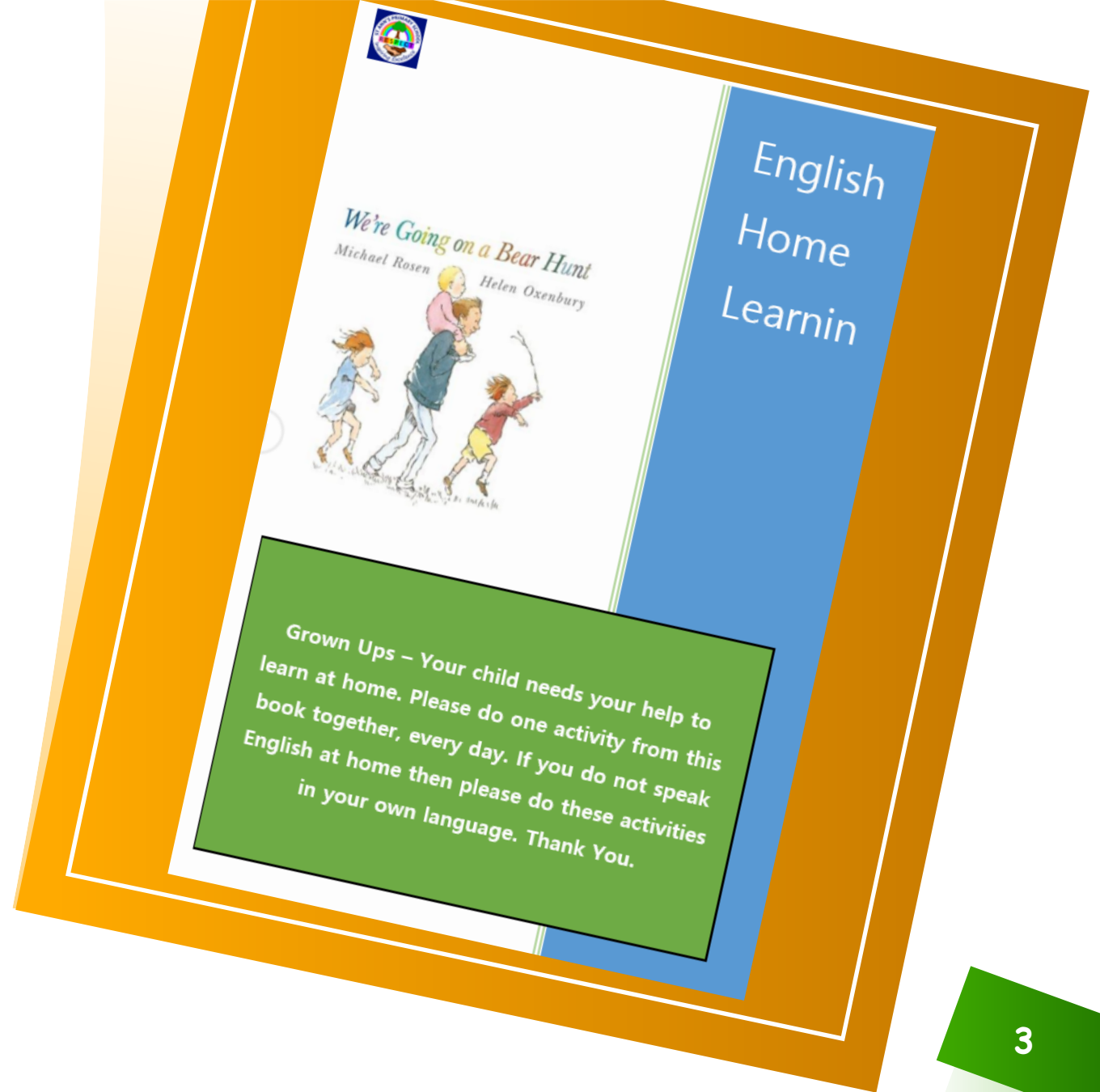
Some of us used Seesaw to connect with our Teachers.



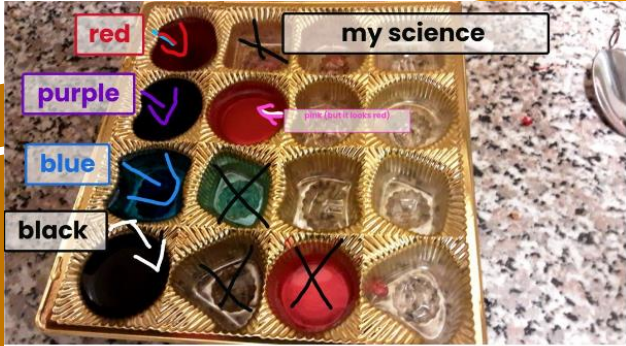




Welcome Back

On the 8<sup>th</sup> March, we finally returned to school. We made time to talk, to connect and kept on learning.



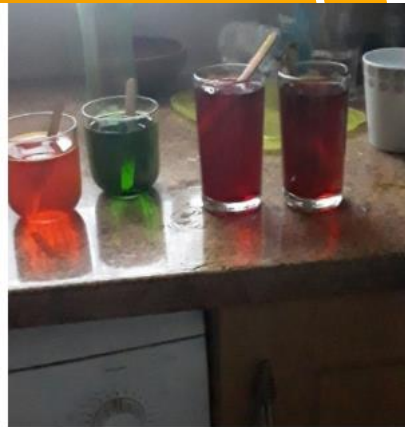
